TRENTO CLASSICO 14/63

Cesarini Sforza, Brut, Val di Cembra, Trentino NV
made & aged like champagne in the foothills of the alps: regal, toasty, driving effervescence

PROSECCO BRUT 12/54

Bianca Vigna, Conegliano, Veneto 2020
polished, premium prosecco from high elevation: crisp orchard fruit, mineral, dry with an elegant mousse

CHAMPAGNE 110

Taittinger 'Cuvee Prestige', Champagne NV
traditional method bubbles from the famed region in France: toasty aromas with an elegant perlage and a long lingering finish

BIANCO

PINOT GRIGIO 12/54

Vigneti del Sole', Veneto 2020 🍷
independent, family owned winery producing light style pinot grigio: dry, crisp, lip-smacking

FIANO DI AVELLINO 15/68

Ciro Picariello, Campania 2021
complex, mineral-driven fiano from a cult producer: struck flint, green apple, bright acidity

VERMENTINO 16/72

Contini, Sardinia 2020
oldest winery on Sardinia. 100% vermentino, all stainless ferment; super crisp, saline, mineral

CHARDONNAY 16/72

Sant'Elena, Friuli Isonzo 2018
unoaked, single varietal produced on the Slovenian border velvety, apricot, golden apple, mineral

ARNEIS 85

Vietti, Piedmont 2021
dry and medium-bodied with crisp acidity, hints of almond and slightly floral aromas; one of the region's native white grapes

RAMATO

GRILLO 17/77

Aldo Viola 'Biancoviola', Sicily 2019
produced by a passionate organic wine producer; this orange blend boasts aromatic citrus notes, earth, with touches of saline

PINOT GRIGIO 14/63

Conte Brandolini D'Adda, Friuli 2021
skin-contact dry "orange" wine from the north; bright copper color, creamy texture, wild strawberries, apple

ROSATO

GAGLIOPPO 13/59

Ippolito 1845, Ciro 'Mabila', Calabria 2021
a delicate and fruity wine with clear notes of sour black cherries and roses

ROSSO

NEBBIOLO 13/59

G.D. Vajra, Piedmont 2021
pure, expressive nebbiolo from the langhe DOC violets, fresh red berries, earthy spice

SANGIOVESE 14/63

Poggio la Noce 'Gigetto', Tuscany 2019
modern, fresh sangiovese made with minimal influence: dry, tart cherries, crushed rocks

MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO 17/77

Torre Raone, Abruzzo, 2020
excellent example of this indigenous variety from central Italy: ripe wild berries, sweet herbs, savory spice

NEGROAMARO 15/68

Trullo Flaminio, Puglia 2019
native to the region and hand-harvested in the south of Italy this dark fruited wine is full-bodied and elegant with refined tannins

CARMIGNANO 21/95

Piaggia 'il Sasso', Tuscany 2020
sangiovese-cabernet 'super tuscan' from outside Florence: bold, dark cherries, fine tannins

VALPOLICELLA SUPERIORE 80

Ilatium Morini 'Campo Prognai', Veneto 2015
complex and structured with intense strawberry jam notes and a long lingering finish

PRIMITIVO 65

Polvanera 'La Marchesana', Puglia 2020
bright and elegant with hints of red berries and violets, a juicy and pure expression of fruit

BAROLO 150

Casa E. de Mirafiore, Piedmont 2015
classic Barolo with notes of dried rose and red cherry with fine, integrated tannins and fresh acidity

BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO 170

Il Palazzone, Tuscany 2017
smooth, savory, and elegantly structured, this Brunello comes from a well-known producer in the rolling hills of Montalcino

CHIANTI CLASSICO RISERVA 220

Fattoria di Felsina 'Berardenga', Tuscany 1994
perfectly aged, an exceptional expression of Chianti with dark cherry and tomato leaf aromas and fine, integrated tannin.

TAURASI RISERVA 125

Michele Perillo, Campania 2009
riserva aglianco from a famed producer: notes of blood orange, smoked meats and grippy tannins

DOLCE

BAROLO CHINATO 12/50

Fontanafredda, Piedmont 2018
a bittersweet digestif made from Barolo wine. Aromatized with Cinchona bark and said to aid digestion

VESPAIOLO PASSITO 82

Maculan 'Acininobili', Veneto 2006
sweet and unctuous, this delicious and complex wine is on par with some of the best in the world
