## SPUMANTE

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### PROSECCO BRUT 13/58

Bianca Vigna, Conegliano, Veneto 2020  
*polished, premium prosecco from high elevation:  
crisp orchard fruit, mineral, dry with an elegant mousse*

### TRENTO CLASSICO 17/77

Cesarini Sforza, Brut, Val di Cembra, Trentino NV  
*made & aged like champagne in the foothills of the alps:  
regal, toasty, driving effervescence*

### LAMBRUSCO 15/68

La Battagliola 'Grasparossa', Modena 2021  
*lively, dry red sparkling wine from Northern Italy with notes of  
bright, crisp cranberry and a complex, lingering finish*

### MOSCATO GIALLO NATURAL 75

Maeli 'Dili', Veneto 2021  
*an exuberantly floral pet-nat that spends three days on skins which  
keeps it hazy and complex. Driven by minerality and a persistent,  
fresh, and boisterous bubble on the palate*

### CHAMPAGNE 160

Taittinger 'Brut Francais', Champagne, France NV  
*traditional method bubbles from the famed region in France:  
toasty aromas with an elegant perlage and a long lingering finish*

## BIANCO

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### PINOT GRIGIO 14/63

Elena Walch, Alto Adige 2022  
*independent, family owned; a crisp and versatile wine with notes of  
ripe pear and white pepper*

### FALANGHINA 13/58

Michele Alois 'Caulino', Campania 2022  
*Volcanic soils from Mount Vesuvio and a terror nerd for a wine-  
maker makes for this delicately textured yet expressive Falanghina,  
a grape native to this region of Campania*

### GRILLO 15/68

Feudo Montoni 'Timpa', Sicily 2021  
*strikingly similar to Sauvignon Blanc, Timpa means strong slope  
and this wine grows on a slope that exceeds a 70% gradient,  
preserving acidity and developing fruit*

### VERMENTINO 16/72

Mora e Memo 'Tino', Sardinia 2022  
*100% vermentino from a legendary producer in Sicily, all stainless  
ferment; super crisp, saline, mineral-driven*

### SAUVIGNON BLANC 17/77

Cantina Kellerei Andriano 'Floreada', Alto Adige 2022  
*gently aromatic and minerally intense, this wine is reflective of the  
unique limestone-rich soils of northern Italy*

### CHARDONNAY 15/68

Sturm 'Andritz', Collio 2021  
*organically farmed and a bit creamy while remaining  
well-balanced with ripe tropical fruit notes and mineral freshness.*

### GEWURZTRAMINER 90

J. Hofstatter, Alto Adige 2021  
*floral with underlying spice and richness, this dry, aromatic  
Tyrolean wine is a luscious white wine with remarkable vivacity*

## ROSATO E RAMATO

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### SANGIOVESE 16/72

La Spinetta 'Il Rose di Casanova', Tuscany 2021  
*tart and floral light rose with hints of salinity and well-integrated  
minerality, crisp and fresh*

### PINOT GRIGIO 14/63

Conte Brandolini D'Adda, Friuli 2021  
*skin-contact dry "orange" wine from the north; bright copper color,  
creamy texture, wild strawberries, apple*

## ROSSO

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### PREMETTA 21/95

Grosjean, Vallé d'Aosta 2022  
*luxurious and persistently fresh on the palate and driven by notes  
of crunchy red berries and violets. Served chilled*

### BRACHETTO 15/68

Angelo Negro, Piedmont 2020  
*fresh and floral with notes of cut strawberries and violets from a  
certified organic winery in the heart of Piedmont*

### NEBBIOLO 14/63

G.D. Vajra, Piedmont 2021  
*pure, expressive nebbiolo from the langhe DOC violets, fresh  
red berries, earthy spice*

### SANGIOVESE 17/77

Poggio la Noce 'Gigetto', Tuscany 2020  
*modern, fresh sangiovese made with minimal influence: dry, tart  
cherries and tomato leaf with balanced tannins*

### MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO 13/58

Torre Raone, Abruzzo, 2021  
*an excellent example of this indigenous variety from central Italy:  
ripe wild berries, sweet herbs, savory spice*

### CABERNET SAUVIGNON 19/86

Ciacci Piccolomini d'Aragona 'Ateo' Tuscany 2021  
*certified organic Super Tuscan style wine with an intense, spicy  
bouquet and juicy black fruit notes*

### FRAPPATO 75

Azienda Agricola COS, Sicily 2022  
*bright and crunchy red fruit - reminiscent of pomegranates and  
cranberries with an underlying freshness that make this wine ridic-  
ulously quaffable. Certified organic*

### DOLCETTO 90

San Fereolo, Dolcetto Dogliani, Piedmont 2015  
*dark ruby red with violet highlights, reminiscent of black wild ber-  
ries and dried leaf. Luscious and vinous with an elegant finish*

### VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO SUPERIORE 80

Pietro Clementi, Ripasso, Veneto 2018  
*juicy black fruit notes, but not at all like Amarone. Made in the  
same region with the same grapes, this lifted style is plush and gen-  
erous, with woody notes of warm spice that keep the wine struc-  
tured and approachable*

### NERELLO MASCALESE 85

Benanti, Etna Rosso, Sicily 2020  
*silky tannins, crunchy red fruits, and complex minerality which have  
come to be a Sicilian signature. Lively and balanced wines from the  
shadow of Mount Etna*

### BARBARESCO 110

Ronchi, Piedmont 2020  
*a classic Barbaresco with delicate notes of dried rose and red cher-  
ry with fine, integrated tannins and fresh acidity*

### BAROLO 150

Marrone, Piedmont 2017  
*a classic Barolo with notes of dried rose and red cherry with fine,  
integrated tannins and fresh acidity*

### CHIANTI CLASSICO RISERVA 220

Fattoria di Felsina 'Berardenga', Tuscany 1994  
*perfectly aged, an exceptional expression of Chianti with dark cher-  
ry and tomato leaf aromas and fine, integrated tannin*

### SUPERTUSCAN 160

Gaja, Ca' Marcanda 'Promis', Tuscany 2021  
*grown right next to the ocean in Bolgheri, this iconic wine is a blend  
of merlot and syrah with a touch of sangiovese. Bold yet supple tan-  
nins and notes of black plum and warm baking spices make this wine  
a joy to pair with a variety of dishes.*
